GUIDE TO AUTHORS

Two types of paper submissions will be accepted:

- 1. Scientific research papers (Full Papers)- mature results or completed research work and should not exceed eight (8) pages.
- 2. Industry reports or in-depth case studies interim results, experiences, and perspectives, mainly for practitioners, and should be up to 3 pages in length, including a short reference section. Papers that meet IEEE standards, with SI not exceeding 20%, will be published in **IEEE Xplore**.

REVIEW PROCESS

- All submissions will be **peer-reviewed** by at least **two independent reviewers**.
- Criteria for evaluation include originality, technical contribution, clarity, and relevance to the conference themes.
- Accepted papers must be presented at the conference. **No-show papers will not be submitted to IEEE Xplore**.

PLAGIARISM, AI AND ETHICS

- Submissions must be original and not simultaneously submitted to another conference or journal.
- All papers will be checked for plagiarism using IEEE CrossCheck (iThenticate). Papers with a similarity index above 30% may be rejected without review.
- Authors are responsible for ensuring proper citation of prior work.

REGISTRATION AND PRESENTATION

- At least **one author** of each accepted paper must register for the conference at the **author registration rate**.
- Accepted and presented papers will be submitted for inclusion in the **IEEE Xplore Digital Library** (subject to IEEE quality review).
